Topic: Discrepancy Reports and Unclaimed Records Posted to Pay Pool Notices

Discussion: The discrepancy reports and unclaimed records are posted to Pay Pool Notices in CAS2Net and are ready for download and review. The quality of pay pool data is critical, and checked in CAS2Net by Pay Pool Administrators in two ways:

- (1) Internal data quality assurance check, via the data maintenance module.
- (2) Review of employee records listed on discrepancy reports.

Discrepancy reports are created by comparing pay pool data in CAS2Net to data from Defense Civilian Personnel Data System (DCPDS). The posting compares the DCPDS extract from September 2018 with CAS2Net data as of 5 September 2018.

Action: Pay Pool Administrators: Please go into the Pay Pool Notices module located in CAS2Net to download the discrepancy and unclaimed records report for your pay pool. Please look for "5 September 2018 Discrepancy Report and Unclaimed Report". Review the employee records identified in the report and make the necessary corrections to the CAS2Net data. If the discrepancy is the result of bad or outdated information from the DCPDS source, follow your organization's Standard Operating Procedures for updating DCPDS. Do not assume that the DCPDS data is correct. If you are unsure, you should request assistance from your Human Resource Office.

Note: A glitch in the DCPDS system caused missing salary data for Army and DCMA. This issues affected September's Discrepancy Report for Army and DCMA and they will not see a Discrepancy Report this month. This also impacted the Unclaimed Report for DCMA and they will not see unclaimed report this month.
